We are holding a symposium to discuss the current challenges for the Pharmaceutical Benefits and Medicare Services Advisory Committees (PBAC and MSAC) in subsidising new and emerging cancer therapies. The meeting is designed to be interactive and will result in developing recommendations to tackle the key challenges in this realm.

Professor Lloyd Sansom, Chair of PBAC and Professor Robyn Ward, Chair of MSAC will be joined by other national and international speakers at the symposium.
