A position has arisen at Royal Perth Hospital (RPH) for a Fellow/ Senior Registrar position in clinical and laboratory haematology in 2019.

The position is suitable for trainees who have completed RACP and RCPA joint training and wish to develop further expertise in clinical research.

The main role of the position is to coordinate and manage the haematology department clinical trials. The department is involved with clinical trials across the spectrum of haematology malignancies with a focus on acute myeloid leukaemia, myeloma and lymphoma

Cell and Tissue Therapies WA (CTTWA) facility is on site at RPH. The haematology department works closely with CTTWA. CTTWA is currently running trials assessing the immunomodulatory effects of mesenchymal stem cells in myelodysplasia, inflammatory bowel disease, organ transplant rejection and cellular therapy approaches to supportive care related to AML induction.

CTTWA is also actively involved with a CAR-T cell therapy developmental program which is expected to transfer from the laboratory to phase 1 clinical studies in the next 6 months.

The successful applicant will interface closely between the haematology department and CTTWA in the development and management of these trials.

Other responsibilities will include laboratory results reporting, consultation and ward duties, and an on call commitment.
